Uttarakhand Board of Technical Education has been setup by an act no - 27 of 2003 as passed by Uttarakhand legislative assembly and assented by governor on 13-January 2004 and notified on 15 - January 2004.

It provides for the establishment and constitution of Board of Technical Education in Uttarakhand and for matters connected there with or incidental there to. The act is enacted by state assembly in 54 years of India. It shall be deemed to have come in to force from the date of notification issued by the state government. It extends to the whole of Uttarakhand state.

Sri Dev Suman Uttarakhand University (SDSUM) is established as a State University of Uttarakhand vide State Government notification No 270/XXXVI(3)/2012/48(1)/2012 dtd 19th October, 2012 in continuation to amendment of erstwhile Pt Deen Dayal Upadhyay Uttarakhand Vishwavidhyalaya Act. 2011 (Uttarakhand Act No 22 of 2011) as notified by State Government vide No 357/XXXVI(3)/2011/57(1)/2010 dated 4th November, 2011.

The establishment of University is a rare distinction of popular and powerful demand and symbolises the hopes and aspiration of the people of Garhwal for the development through the instrument of higher education. The masses of this remote mountainous region demanded for opening a new University at Badshahi Thual, a small but historical town of Tehri Garhwal of Uttarakhand. It was an expression of the quest for empowering their future generation for overcoming endemic economic and social backwardness, geographic and environmental constraints.

# RULES AND POLICIES

## RAGGING

Any disorderly conduct whether by spoken words or written or by an act which has the effect of teasing, or handling with rudeness any other student, in rowdy or undisciplined activities which causes or is likely to cause annoyance, hardship or psychological harm or to raise fear or apprehension thereof in a fresher or a junior student or asking the students to do any act or perform something which such student will not do in the ordinary course and which has the effect of causing or generating a sense of shame or embarrassment so as to adversely affect the physique or psyche of a fresher or a junior student.

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## CONSTITUTION OF ANTI-RAGGING BODIES

### Anti-Ragging Committee

The Anti-Ragging Committee shall be headed by the Director and shall consist of representatives of faculty members, parents, students belonging to the freshers' category as well as seniors and non-teaching staff. It shall monitor the anti-ragging activities in the institution, consider the recommendations of the Anti-Ragging Squad and take appropriate decisions, including spelling out suitable punishments to the found guilty.

### Anti-Ragging Squad

The Anti-Ragging Squad shall be nominated by the Director with such representation as considered necessary and shall consist of members belonging to the various sections of the campus community. The Squad shall have vigil, oversight and patrolling functions. It shall be kept mobile, alert and active at all times and shall be empowered to inspect places of potential ragging and make surprise raids on hostels and other host posts.

### Anti-Ragging Students Squad

Anti-Ragging students Squad shall be nominated by Director, Chief Warden and shall consist of the student members belonging to the senior batches. These students shall keep constant vigil and will be moving around premises and nearby areas of College.

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## PUNISHMENT FOR RAGGING DEPENDING UPON THE GRAVITY OF THE OFFENCE

- i. Lodging FIR against offender.
  - ii. Rigorous Imprisonment for up to 3 years (under the court of law).
  - iii. Fine up to Rs. 2,50,000 (up to Rs 2.5 lakh)
  - iv. Rustication from the University for varying periods.
  - v. Expulsion from the University and consequent debarring.
  - vi. Cancellation of Admission.
  - vii. Suspension from attending classes.
  - viii. Withholding/withdrawing of scholarship and other benefits.
  - ix. Debarring from appearing for any test/examination/placement activities organized by the College.
  - x. Withholding of results.
  - xi. Debarring from representing the College in any National or International meet, tournament and festival.
  - xii. Suspension / Expulsion from the hostel.
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## ATTENDANCE

All students must obtain 75% attendance to be eligible for the University Examination.

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Any candidate who does not have adequate attendance & progress in any subject will not be permitted for the examination.

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All internal examination will be compulsory and internal marks will be awarded as per the University rules and regulations.

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Attendance on first day of the session is mandatory.

## FEES

Students must deposit the fees and the dues, if any, at the time of registration and within the prescribed date for each semester.

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In no case, any delay in registration and fees deposit will not be permitted

## REFUND

Fees once paid are not refundable under any circumstances at all.

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After admission the amount paid as fees will stand absorbed by the institute for all the students, whether studying or withdrawn or expelled from the roll of institute.
